EXPULSION POLICY

Unfortunately, there are sometimes reasons we have to expel a child from our program either on a short term or permanent basis. We want you to know that we will do everything possible to work with the family of the child(ren) in order to prevent this policy from being enforced. The following are reasons we may have to expel or suspend a child from this center:

IMMEDIATE CAUSES FOR EXPULSION

The child is at risk of causing serious injury to other children or him/herself and the parent refuses intervention efforts to help the child.

Parents threaten physical or intimidating actions towards PPLA staff members or other parents.

Parents exhibit verbal abuse to staff or other PPLA parents in front of enrolled children.

PARENTAL ACTIONS FOR CHILD'S EXPULSION

Failure to pay/habitual lateness in making childcare payments without prior discussion with the director.

Failure to complete required forms including the child's immunization records and failure to keep said immunizations up to date.

Habitual tardiness when picking up your child without failure to plan with the director.

Verbal/Physical abuse to staff, PPLA parents or children.

CHILD'S ACTIONS FOR EXPULSION

Failure of a child to adjust to the program after a reasonable amount of time.

Uncontrollable tantrums/angry outbursts after interventions have been exhausted.

Ongoing physical or verbal abuse to staff or other children after interventions have been exhausted.

Excessive biting after interventions have been exhausted.

Prior to expulsion, a parent will be called and correspondence will be sent home indicating what the problem is, and every effort will be made by both the center and the parent to correct the problem. If, after one or two weeks, depending on the

risk to other children's welfare or safety, behavior does not improve, and the center finds that they can no longer accommodate the child, the parent will be asked to remove him/her. The parent will be given a minimum of two week notice to find another center to provide care for this child.
